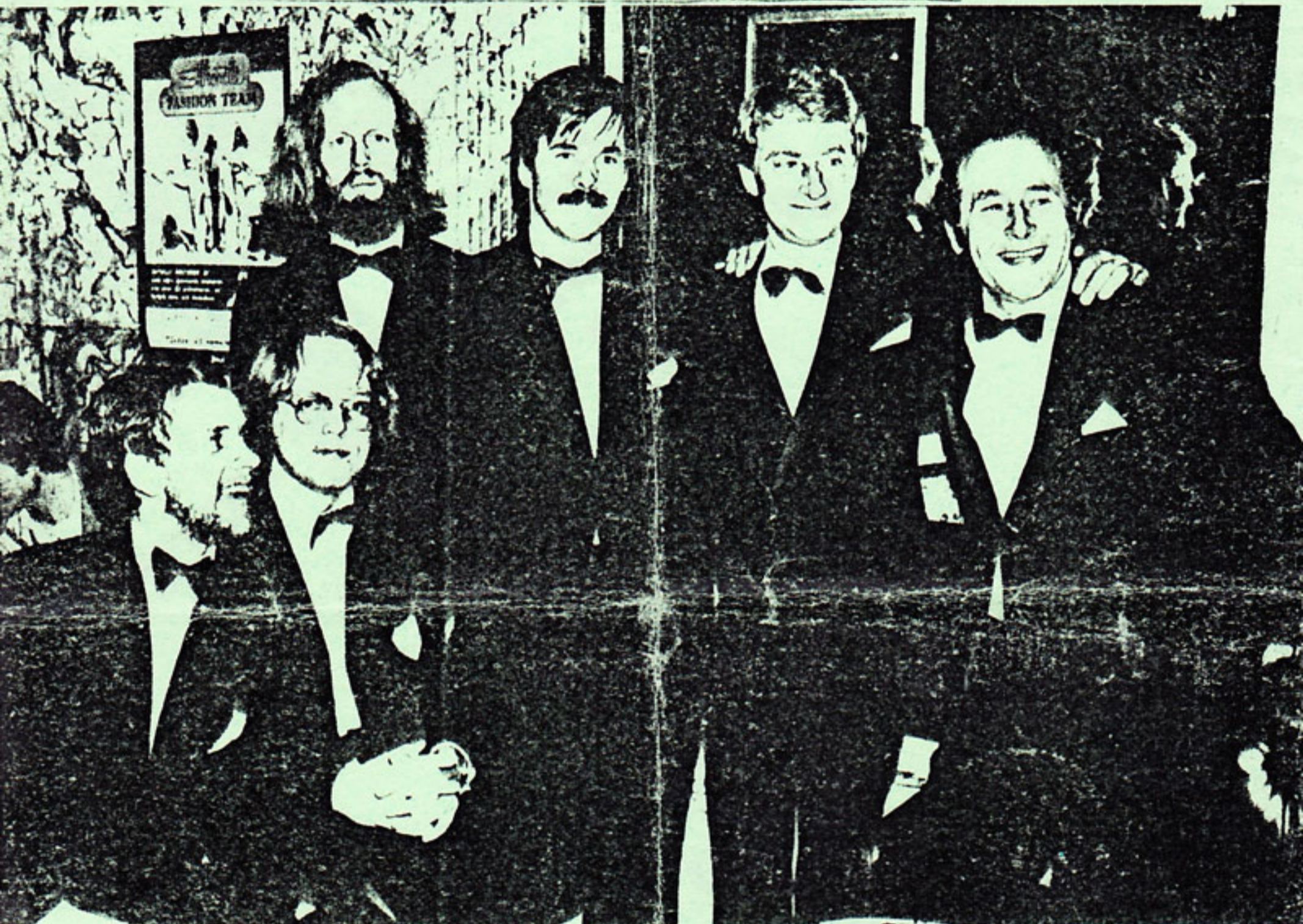

## SCANIAZZ 1982

SCANIAZZ from southern Sweden has gained world-wide reputation for performing the "classic" jazz in their own personal way which, as it happens, is close to the spirit of the original early jazz. Inspired by the thousands of recordings from the twenties, while spending much time to dig out the best material, the band has a program that contains many long-forgotten compositions.

In 1975, the orchestra made their first appearances at international jazz festivals and after receiving enthusiastic ovations in San Sebastian, Spain that year, the success was continued at the Old Style Jazz Festival in Breda, Holland in 1976 and 1977 where they were tremendously appreciated. The band that represented a new generation was appointed to "one of the ten best old style orchestras in the world" and it was also at those festivals that Scaniazz was "discovered" by the Americans, which has resulted in records for the U.S. label Stomp Off Records. Since then much time has been spent on touring Holland, Belgium, England, Germany among other countries and now, when the band makes their first visit to the U.S.A., it's better than ever.
